





#### BERLIN BROTHERSVALLEY HIGH SCHOOL'S CORNERSTONE

The cornerstone for the Berlin Brothersvalley High School was laid on May 23, 1936 by the Referend Dr. D. S. Stephen. The building was dedicated by Dr. Lee L. Driver, former Chief of Consolidation and Transportation in the Department of Public Instruction in Harrisburg.

The class of 1938 was the first graduating class in the new high school building.
