

RECENT DONATIONS

Maria Craig donated a flow blue pitcher and a relish dish. **Larry and Pam Custer** loaned us their Berlin Class of 1970's 55th year reunion picture to copy for our archives. **Eugene and Emily Bittner** donated a stereoscope and two boxes of viewfinder pictures; post cards, several beaded pocketbooks and miscellaneous items. One beaded pocketbook made in the 1880s belonged to Lizzie (Levy) Altfather and was given to her granddaughter, Evelyn (Altfather) Engleka. Another beaded pocketbook was a Christmas gift in the 1930's to Evelyn from her parents, Lewis and Helen (Miller) Altfather. Another beaded pocketbook was hand made in the 1880s or before by Marguerite Dively (Levy) Valentine. Also donated was a beaded pocketbook (1930s) made by Evelyn Engleka's Aunt Isabelle Chonetts.
